

## PLACEMENT SCALE

Scores are obtained either from the On-line Placement Exam or the Proctored Confirmation Exam during New Student Orientation.

Note for students with SAT II scores: even though you may use your SAT II score to enroll in a course, the French Department strongly urges you to take the On-line Placement Exam for the most accurate placement. If your SAT II score is different from your score on the Placement or Confirmation Exam, you should follow the recommendation of the Placement or Confirmation Exam.
