

## Accents on Macintosh

To type accented characters on a Macintosh, hold the **Option** key as you press the accent. Then let go of both keys and type the letter itself.

**1. Accent aigu (é):** type Option-**E** followed by the vowel.

Example: To type the lower case é, hold down the **Option** key, then the **E** key. Release both keys then type lowercase **e**.

**2. Accent grave (à, è):** Option-~ followed by the vowel. The ~ key is in the upper left of the keyboard.

Example: To type à, hold down the **Option** key and the ~ key. Release both keys and type **a**.

**3. Accent circonflexe (â, ê, î, ô, û):** Option-**I** followed by the vowel.

Example: To type ô, hold down the **Option** key and the **I** key. Release both keys and type **o**.

**4. Cédille (ç):** Option-**C**.

**5. Tréma (ë):** Option-**U** followed by the vowel.
